



Great locations!

ADA BORUP: In the Northeast part of MN, this rich in tradition sports community has added a facility to there high school. Four full size, air conditioned courts off this area a prime opportunity for teams.

ALEXANDRIA: A beautiful facility awaits with five hardwood floors and air conditioning. This is at the new Alexandria Area High School.

ANOKA RAMSEY COMMUNITY COLLEGE: Anoka Ramsey in the North Metro has 3 full sized courts and great location and parking.

AUSTIN: Southern MN Gem has four full courts and great for teams in Southern MN and Iowa.

BLOOMINGTON KENNEDY: A terrific state-of-the-art facility that is simply the best site in Minnesota for seating, full-sized courts, and creating a big-time atmosphere for this event.

CONCRODIA ST PAUL (NEW): Home of the Division II Power Golder Bears. This site in St. Paul has four courts, a perfect setting for Basketball

DELANO: This site has 6 full size regular courts, 2 courts are wood and 4 are synthetic surface and all courts are together at one site. Great location and also air conditioned.

FARIBAULT: Just south of Metro area on I-35, this location has 4 full sized courts and great location for teams from all over MN with great access.

FERGUS FALLS: A new high school with state of the art facilities, Fergus Falls has a fully air-conditioned gym.

HASTINGS: A great location to the entrance of Southern MN. This facility has 5 great courts all in the same location.

KASSON-MANTORVILLE: Near Rochester, this high school has three full sized courts, air-conditioned with more courts possible. Great location for teams in metro, central and southern Minnesota.

MANKATO: On the beautiful campus of Minnesota State at Mankato. A hotbed of hoops with 11 total courts — seven wood — and fully air-conditioned.

MAPLE GROVE: The outstanding Maple Grove Jr. High facility has 5 air-conditioned courts.

MARSHALL: A southwestern Minnesota hotbed, host to the Marshall Tigers, features all air-conditioned facility and four wood floors.

MOORHEAD: At the high school, six total courts with two wood courts, and all air-conditioned. At the middle school, three wood courts with air conditioning.

MORA: Great facility with a total of 7 courts and location on the eastern MN side.

MORRIS: Home of the Tigers, Morris in Western Minnesota can allow up to 9 courts, also using the University of Minnesota-Morris.

MOUNTAIN IRON-BUHL: New gym opened in the fall of 2018, with three wood courts in an air-conditioned setting. Great Iron Range setting for northeastern Minnesota programs.

PAYNESVILLE: This new Fieldhouse opened in 2021, all air conditioned, courts in same location, and is great location between Willmar and St Cloud in Central Minnesota.

PEQUOT LAKES: One of the best high school facilities in the Brainerd Lakes area. Five courts, four with wood floors, and all air-conditioned. A very popular location connecting many parts of Minnesota.

PERHAM: Great new school facility with all wood floors (except court No. 5 at the elementary) and air-conditioned gyms. The "Hive" is new and the other gyms are in excellent shape.

PRIOR LAKE: A south metro hot spot that has 4 all wood floors in the High School, and newly built fieldhouse than can have 10 courts going at once. This will be one of the best sites of the Summer.

ST. CLOUD TECH: Brand new high school built in 2019, Tech has four full sized wood floors with great spectator space. Located off of MN State Highway 15 for great access from all highways.

ST LOUIS PARK: Four great wood courts and Central Metro area and home to the Orioles. Great location for all teams and easy access and parking.

ST. MICHAEL-ALBERTVILLE: Has eight courts, all air-conditioned in a terrific facility. This tourney is our biggest, with 60+ teams per day.

SAUK RAPIDS: Located at beautiful Sauk Rapids-Rice High School with four hardwood courts and air conditioning. We also use the Whitney Center with three hardwood courts.

SW CHRISTIAN: One the newest facilities in the metro area that has 5 wood courts and beautiful sight lines that will make this location of the nicest in Minnesota.

TARTAN: Home of the Titans in East Metro, Tartan has four full sized wood courts with there new expansion.


WACONIA: Seven wood floors that can host many teams from newly expanded high school. A popular site from all areas of Minnesota.
